The Uncornered model harnesses the power of Core Influencers at the heart of a community to create a thriving city from the inside out. Our model is driven by data that allows us to analyze and drive impact on a community level, street by street and corner by corner.

Data has proven the right Core Influencers, when recruited from the right network and provided the right support, will **end street violence.** Investing in the potential of the city's most disruptive and neglected residents creates opportunity and **hope for all.**




### **■ DRAMATIC REDUCTION IN SHOOTINGS | KANSAS CITY**

Following the 3 deadliest years on record in Kansas City, Uncornered Core Influencers paved the way to a drastic 35% reduction in shootings in Q3. This is especially striking given summer months are the most violent in cities, and it stands as the largest single-quarter reduction in shootings Uncornered has ever seen.



## **■ GROWING IMPACT OF CORE INFLUENCERS | PROVIDENCE**

The number of leads, Catalysts and networks has increased by more than 4x, enabling even greater impact across the city.


Our fundraising goals will enable us to continue delivering transformational change in the cities we are operating in, while simultaneously extending our reach to new areas.

At full-scale funding, we will drastically reduce shootings in Uncornered cities.


